



Director of Acting Programs

Job Posting

The Director of Acting Programs reports to the CEO with regards to artistic aspects of Acting programs and to the Director of Programs on matters of curriculum, evaluation, budgetary, strategic planning and day to day operations of the department. The Director of Acting Programs provides leadership, oversight and management of artistic, performance and educational objectives in support of the Mosaic's mission. This is a full time position requiring afternoon, evening and weekend working hours.

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Provides appropriate artistic and educational experiences for young artists ages 11-18 in Mosaic Acting Company which include but are not limited to:
 - Supervises acting auditions;
 - Attends and facilitates all rehearsals for Mosaic Acting Company;
 - Travels with the acting company to local, regional and national performances;
 - Selects and supervises the Assistant Director of Acting.

- Responsible for the quality of all theatrical performances given by Mosaic Youth Theatre of Detroit. Related duties include, but are not limited to:
 - Director or Acting Coach for all stage productions;
 - Participation in selection of scripts;
 - Primary responsibility for theatrical elements of production (e.g. lights, sound, sets and props).
 - Leads and collaborates with the director of Choral Programs in the selection of contract artists and designers for all productions;
 - Creates and Manages budget for key stage productions;
 - Participates in the selection and supervises Production Manager, guest artists, and instructors;

- Responsible for the design and implementation of the acting curriculum and the evaluation of the efficacy of Mosaic's acting programs.
- Reports on Mosaic Main Stage program outcomes to senior management in collaboration with the Director of Choral Programs and the Youth Support Director.

- Experience working with youth ages 11-18
